Dear Applicant,

Thank you for considering this Missionary In Training program.

Mount Abarim's MIT program is promoted and run in cooperation with several other ministries. MIT is a two-week training program designed to encourage high school students that are seeking God's calling on their life.

Applicants should be 15 to 19 years of age at the time of this program. This program is not automatically filled on a first-come, first-served basis but rather through this application process.

Your completed application should include several forms. (all of which are downloadable by following the links at www.AllOutForGod.com). All of these forms must be returned to our home office in order to be considered for the program.

This Application:

This application will take time and should be filled out thoughtfully. It is very important that you are thorough in your answers. We do not expect perfection, but we do expect honesty in your answers. This form includes an application for 1 week of camp (this application has been modified, please do not use the application provided by the camp) and should be sent to our office as well.

Parent/Guardian & Transportation Forms:

This form allows us to accompany you for the entire two-week period - at camp, ground transportation, air travel, hotel housing, and public transportation. Please send this form even though you may be considered a legal adult.

Recommendation Forms:

Three recommendation forms must be filled out and returned by two church officials (pastor, youth pastor, associate pastor, deacon, etc.) and one by another adult of your choice (not a parent). Since these recommendation forms need to be mailed separately, it would be helpful to also give them a stamped, addressed envelope along with the recommendation form. You will need to stay in touch with those that you have asked to recommend you to make sure that they have mailed their form to us. We cannot process the MIT application until all three forms are received.

Mt. Abarim can only accept a limited number of applicants into MIT. For priority consideration, please complete and return your 1) MIT application and forms, 2) Camp application and forms, and 3) the recommendation forms as soon as possible. Accepted applicants will be notified by mail (or by email if possible) within one week of their acceptance.
